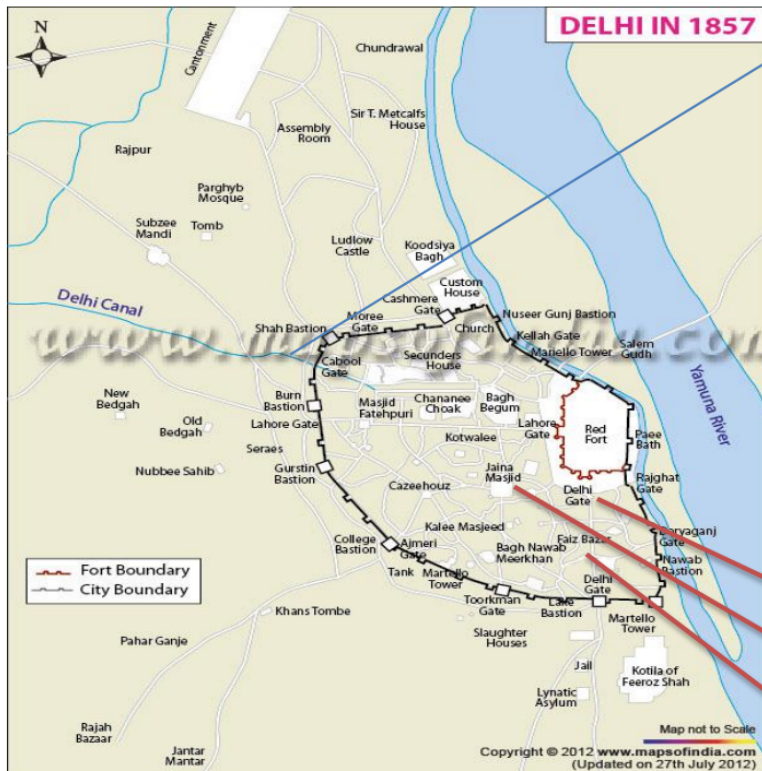


Delhi remains one of the oldest surviving cities in the world today .

A part of Delhi is shown in map showing distinctive feature describe below :-

1857 – (19th century)

This part of Delhi was made by Mughal Emperor Shahjahan on the banks of the river Yamuna. The notable landmarks which he built in this walled city, also called Shahjahanabad, were the impressive Red Fort or Lal Qila and the Jama Masjid as shown in pic which is like square as described in course for public place .

Moreover as it was made near river , many people might visit easily as we can see bazar and houses near river.

The walled city had a number of gates or entry points -Ajmeri, Moree, Cashmere or Kashmiri, Toorkman, and Lahore
